~ נְטִילַת יָדַיִם ~

We must wash our hands with water as soon as possible after awakening in the morning.

Children should also wash their hands upon arising in the morning.

One should try to arrange having the water close to where he sleeps so that he will not have to walk more than אַמּוֹת ד' (about two metres) before being able to wash his hands.

Before washing נְטִילַת יָדַיִם one should not touch open parts of the body (mouth, eyes, nose, ears) or food.
