| <b>Citron</b> : resembles the <b>heart</b> .<br>The "Etrog" has both a pleasant taste and a pleasant smell, symbolizing one who possesses <b>both knowledge of Torah and good deeds</b> .       | אֶתְרוֹג  | _____                          |
| <b>3 Myrtle</b> branches: resemble the <b>eyes</b> .<br>The "Hadas" has a pleasant smell only, and symbolizes the person who has <b>good deeds but not Torah</b> .                              | הַדָּסִים | _____                          |
