'יום כיפור' is on the 10th of תשרי. On Yom Kippur we may not eat, drink, wash, wear leather shoes, or wear make-up. We may rinse our hands until the knuckles. In each service the צל חטא (Al Chet) prayer is said, in which we confess our sins.	יום כיפור	_____
