### Read Rav Elon's introductory D'var Torah.

- 1) With what command does this Parasha open?
- 2) In which mitzva does Rav Elon say we find the greatest level of holiness?
- 3) Can you explain why caring for others is holy behaviour?

### Now read the story, "The Tefillin and the Flowerpot."

- 4) What does it mean to judge others favourably?
- 5) How should one rebuke (tell off) another person when it appears they are doing wrong?
- 6) What lessons can we learn from this story?

### Now look elsewhere in the daf to answer these:

- 7) The command not to steal is given twice in the Torah. What two types of theft does the Torah mean to forbid?
- 8) How would you explain to someone that it is wrong to lie?
- 9) What four categories of produce would be set aside for the poor during the harvest?
- 10) a. What two types of fabric may not be worn in the same garment?  
b. What is the name given to cloth containing such a mixture?
- 11) Can you explain the three reasons given in the daf for why we do not say the beracha "Shehecheyanu" when we count the Omer?
- 12) a. Why do we make a special effort during the Omer to work on our behaviour and our relationships with others?  
b. May a person count with a beracha if he can not remember whether he counted at all on the previous night?
