<p style="text-align: center;">Summary of the פְּרָשָׁה, by עליות</p> <p>פְּתוּחַ שָׁרָה died in חֲבֵרוֹן הוא אַרְבַּע at the age of 127. אַבְרָהָם bought מַעֲרַת הַמְּכַפְּלָה from עֶפְרוֹן for 400 silver shekels.</p> <p>כּוּן אַבְרָהָם buried שָׁרָה in מַעֲרַת הַמְּכַפְּלָה . מַעֲרַת אַבְרָהָם sent his servant, אֱלִיעֶזֶר , to find a wife for יִצְחָק .</p> <p>שְׁלִישִׁי אֱלִיעֶזֶר went with ten camels and arrived at "אֲרָם נְהָרִים אֶל-עִיר נְחֹזֵר". He stopped at a well, in the evening, when the women were coming out to draw water. He asked ה' for a sign - he would ask a woman for water, and the one who would give not only him but also his camels would be the right one for יִצְחָק. רַבְקָה came out and passed this test. אֱלִיעֶזֶר gave her a golden nose ring and two arm bracelets. He asked who she was and whether there was room in her father's house for him to spend the night. She introduced herself as the daughter of בְּתוּאֵל, and said she had food for the animals and room for lodging.</p> <p>רביעי רַבְקָה ran to tell her family about what had happened. אֱלִיעֶזֶר ran out to אֱלִיעֶזֶר and invited him back to their home. אֱלִיעֶזֶר entered their house, unmuzzled his camels (<i>"רש"י reminds us that אַבְרָהָם's livestock were always muzzled when they were away from home to stop them grazing in other people's fields.</i>), fed his camels and washed his feet and those of the men with him. Then he told his hosts who he was, why he had come, the test he had set and how רַבְקָה had passed it.</p>	<p>בְּרֵאשִׁית נח לֶדֶד-לֶדֶד וַיֵּרָא חיי שָׁרָה תּוֹלְדוֹת וַיֵּצֵא וַיִּשְׁלַח וַיֵּשֶׁב מִקֶּץ וַיִּגַּשׁ וַיְחִי</p>
<p>חמישי אֱלִיעֶזֶר gave objects of silver and gold, and garments, to רַבְקָה. He gave delicious fruits to her brother and mother. אֱלִיעֶזֶר and the men with him ate, drank and spent the night there. In the morning אֱלִיעֶזֶר asked to be sent back to his master. They did not want רַבְקָה to go, but when he pressured them they asked רַבְקָה what she wanted and she was happy to go. רַבְקָה, her sister and nurse, אֱלִיעֶזֶר and his men left. יִצְחָק went out into the field to pray before nightfall. He raised his eyes and saw camels coming. רַבְקָה saw him and asked who he was. When אֱלִיעֶזֶר told her it was his master, רַבְקָה covered herself with her veil. אֱלִיעֶזֶר told יִצְחָק everything he had done. יִצְחָק married רַבְקָה and he loved her (because of her good deeds - Ramban).</p> <p>ששי אַבְרָהָם married again, taking a wife called קַטֹּרָה . The תּוֹרָה lists their children and grandchildren. אַבְרָהָם gave all he had to יִצְחָק , while he gave gifts to the children of his other wives then sent them away from יִצְחָק . אַבְרָהָם lived to 175. He died. יִצְחָק and יִשְׁמַעֵאל buried him in מַעֲרַת הַמְּכַפְּלָה .</p> <p>שביעי The תּוֹרָה lists the children of יִשְׁמַעֵאל . יִשְׁמַעֵאל lived to the age of 137.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Pirkei Avot</p> <p>שמעון הצדיק was among the survivors of the Great Assembly. He used to say: The world depends on three things - on תּוֹרָה study, on the service [of ה'], and on kind deeds.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">פְּרָקֵי אָבוֹת</p> <p>שמעון הצדיק היה משיירי כנסת הגדולה. הוא היה אומר, על שלשה דברים העולם עומד, על התורה ועל העבודה ועל גמילות חסדים:</p>

And יִצְחָק brought her (רַבְּקָה) into the tent of שָׂרָה , his mother; he married רַבְּקָה , she became his wife, and he loved her; and in that was יִצְחָק consoled after his mother.

<p>רש"י writes (from the מדרש):</p> <p>As long as שָׂרָה was alive, a lamp burned in her tent from one ערב שבת to the next, her dough was blessed, and a cloud of Hashem's presence hung over her tent.</p> <p>When שָׂרָה died these blessings ceased, but when רַבְּקָה entered the tent, the ברכות returned.</p>	<p>רש"י בראשית פרק כד פסוק סז</p> <p>(סז) הָאֵהָלָה שָׂרָה אִמּוֹ - וַיְבִיחָהּ הָאֵהָלָה וַיִּנְטְשִׁית דּוֹגְמַת שָׂרָה אִמּוֹ, כְּלוּמַר וְכִי הָיָה שָׂרָה אִמּוֹ, שָׂכַל זְמַן שֶׁשָׂרָה קִיּוּמָת הָיָה נֵר דְּלוּק מִתְּעַרְצ שֶׁצֶת לְעַרְצ שֶׁצֶת, וְזָרְקָה מְלוּוִיָּה צְעִיסָה, וְעִנּוֹן קָשׁוּר עַל הָאֵהָלָה, וּמִשְׁמַתָּה פְּסָקוֹ, וּכְשֶׁצָּחַת רַבְּקָה חָזְרוּ:</p>
