<p align="center">עלויות by פְּרֻשָׁה, Summary of the</p> <p>פְּתוּחַ tells אַבְרָם to leave his home. אַבְרָם goes to כְּנָעַן with שָׂרִי and his nephew, לוֹט. ה' promises to give the land to אַבְרָם's descendants. אַבְרָם goes down to מִצְרַיִם to escape famine. אַבְרָם asks שָׂרִי to tell the מִצְרַיִם that she is his sister.</p> <p>לִי is taken by פְּרַעֲוֹה but he treats אַבְרָם well for her sake, giving him servants and animals. ה' strikes פְּרַעֲוֹה with plagues. פְּרַעֲוֹה returns שָׂרִי to אַבְרָם and tells him to leave מִצְרַיִם.</p> <p>שְׁלִישִׁי A quarrel breaks out between the shepherds of אַבְרָם and those of לוֹט. (See רש"י for the reason for the argument) אַבְרָם says to לוֹט that they should separate, which they do. אַבְרָם dwells in כְּנָעַן and לוֹט camps as far as סְדֵם. ה' repeats his promise to make אַבְרָם's descendants as the dust of the earth.</p> <p>רְבִיעִי There is a war between the four kings and the five kings. לוֹט is captured by the four kings. אַבְרָם, with 318 armed men (or just his servant, אֶלְעָזָר, according to the מִדְרָשׁ), rescued לוֹט.</p> <p>חֲמִישִׁי אַבְרָם refuses honours from the king of סְדֵם. ה' tells אַבְרָם that his descendants will be as many as the stars.</p> <p>שֵׁשִׁי ה' says that אַבְרָם's descendants will be slaves in a foreign land but will leave with great wealth. He adds that he has given כְּנָעַן to אַבְרָם's descendants. שָׂרִי gives הָגָר to אַבְרָם. הָגָר bears יִשְׁמָעֵאל when אַבְרָם is 86 years old. א וַיֹּאמֶר ה' אֶל־אַבְרָם לֵךְ־לְךָ מֵאֶרֶץ וּמִמּוֹלַדְתְּךָ וּמִבֵּית אָבִיךָ אֶל־הָאָרֶץ אֲשֶׁר אֶרְאֶה:
'ה said to אַבְרָם: "Go for yourself from your land, from your birthplace and from your father's house, to the land that I will show you."

בְּרֵאשִׁית פָּרָק י"ג

ז וַיְהִי־רִיב בֵּין רְעֵי מִקְנֵה־אַבְרָם וּבֵין רְעֵי מִקְנֵה־לוֹט וְהִכְנַעְנִי וְהִפְרִיז אִזּוּ יָשָׁב בְּאֶרֶץ:
There was a dispute between the herdsmen of אַבְרָם's flocks and those of לוֹט.

In the first פְּסוּק, above, ה' is telling אַבְרָם to leave the bad influences of his homeland. The dispute in the second פְּסוּק, above, leads to אַבְרָם deciding that he and לוֹט should split up - אַבְרָם is not happy about the bad influence of לוֹט's shepherds.

If we feel that those around us are being a bad influence, either on ourselves or on others, then we should take steps to distance ourselves from them.

Look in your סִידוּר at the long בְּרָכָה at the end of בְּרַכַּת הַשַּׁחַר, which begins הַמַּעֲבִיר. Find the words which mean: "Distance us from an evil person and an evil companion."
